

TAPESTRY 3

Apocalypse or global sustainability, Golden Wall

Supplemented call for applications

The Hungarian Association of Tapestry Artists – in cooperation with the Hungarian Academy of Arts and Museum of Fine Arts – is organizing an international tapestry exhibition entitled *Apocalypse or Global Sustainability* between 13 April and 16 July 2017. Any tapestry artists can participate in this exhibition joining the creation of the large wall carpet installation 'Golden Wall'. This jointly made work of art can be the woven ensemble of the artists creating in the language of wall tapestry, it can present today's diversity and colourful abundance of this genre. The large wall tapestry will make a separate work of art from 20 x 20 cm units woven by traditional tapestry technique. They will follow the theme of *Apocalypse or global sustainability* and golden thread (old gold) will appear in the woven textures. If the individual plan requires it is possible to make 20x40, 40x20, or 40x40 cm units. The tapestries of 4 and 5 density of warp must be made by the artists in their own workshops in a form ready to exhibit, with lining on their back and velcro on the top and at the bottom. The woven works of the members of the Association of Hungarian Tapestry Artists must be submitted on 1 February 2016 between 15.00 and 18.00, artists who are not members of the Association can submit their works on 3 September 2016 between 15.00 and 18.00 or can send them. The address where the works must be handed in or sent to is the head office of the Association of Hungarian Tapestry Artists (1117 Budapest, Hamzsabégyi út 8). The participants are required to attach the official application form of Tapestry 3 to their works.
